Manufacturer's Warranty

The Bertha High Velocity Accordion Hurricane Shutter manufactured by All World Shutters, Inc. shall carry a Limited Warranty for a term of 36 months on the Product Parts and 36 months on the Paint and Aluminum Profiles. The Manufacturer warrants and represents that the Product will conform to the Description and Specifications and be free from defects in material and workmanship.

Hardware and aluminum finishes shall be properly maintained to qualify for coverage under this limited warranty. The Product must be cleaned, debris removed and moving parts lubricated no less than semi-annually (every six months).

THIS WARRANTY SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE PRODUCT OR ANY PART THEREOF WHICH HAS BEEN SUBJECT TO ACCIDENT, NEGLIGENCE, ACTS OF GOD, ALTERATION, ABUSE, MISUSE, OR HAVE BEEN USED BY THE BUYER OR THE END USER IN CONTRAVENTION OF THE REQUIREMENTS AND DIRECTIONS OF THE MANUFACTURER. THESE WARRANTY SHALL APPLY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES.

Description and Specifications:

Products sold as impact resistant have been tested to comply with Miami-Dade Building Dept. & Florida Building Code requirements for high velocity hurricane zone use.

The Bertha High Velocity Accordion Hurricane Shutter was tested by impacting with both, blown missiles and varying wind pressures under controlled laboratory conditions. Each assembly must resist penetration from a large missile; a wood stud weighing 9 pounds fired end-on at 34 mph. The assembly is then subjected to 9000 cycles of push and pull force at increasing pressures that simulate the strong positive and negative wind pressures of a hurricane. Assemblies that have passed the large missile test are deemed to have passed a small missile (such as airborne roof gravel) test.

These tests, when successful, culminate in the award of a missile impact rating and a pressure rating for stated assembly sizes, called a Notice of Acceptance that is issued by Miami-Dade County and/or the Florida Building Commission.

The purpose of impact resistant products and their testing under building codes is to preserve the building envelope against explosion due to penetration of high velocity winds and internal pressurization during a hurricane.
